

BROAD STREET RECYCLING CENTER

The town of Medway is now operating the Recycling Center located on Broad Street and is open to residents of Medway who have paid the Town's trash fee. The Center is open as follows:

Wednesday 2011 Summer Hours: 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. (March 16 through November 4)
 2010 Winter Hours: 12 noon to 3:00 p.m. (November 10 through March 13)
 Sat. & Sun. 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.



- Mixed Paper/Cardboard - FREE
- Co-mingled broken down containers - FREE
- UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Anything gas powered, white goods, appliances, car batteries, glass doors or glass windows or electrical items. These items are picked up Tuesdays by **APPOINTMENT ONLY**.
- Brush & Branches (no stumps max diameter 6 in) - FREE
- Wood - (Bulk) see Town of Medway website: www.townofmedway.org for fee schedule
- Tires (remove rims) - FREE
- No "Construction and/or Demolition Materials" (Shingles, Wallboard, tiles, insulation, brick, cement)
- CLOTHING- A yellow planet aid receptacle will now be at the recycling center for the collection of **CLEAN CLOTHING ONLY**

HOLIDAY CLOSINGS: The Recycling Center will be closed on Christmas Day Saturday, December 25, 2010 and Easter Sunday, April 24, 2011.

All vehicles entering the Recycling Center must have stickers. They can be purchased at Towns Solid Waste/Recycling Center Office for \$15.00 each. Stickers should be placed on the back of the rear view mirror of your vehicle.

All Commercial users must obtain a special permit from the Towns Solid Waste/Recycling Center Office

Town of Medway - Trash & Recycling Guide - 7/1/10- 6/30/11

At the Annual Town Meeting in 1999, Medway residents voted to replace the existing trash system with a "Pay As You Throw" system of trash collection. Only trash in specially printed yellow Medway trash bags will be collected curbside and can be purchased at the following locations:

Condon's Hardware, 114 Main Street, Medway
Cumberland Farms, 126 Main Street, Medway

Roche Bros., Route 109, Millis
Shaws/Star Market, 67 Main St., Medway
Hannafords Supermarket, Route 109, Milford

Walgreens, 68 Main St., Medway
Medway Mart, 141 Village Street, Medway
Anne's Market, 82 Main Street, Medway

A 30-gallon bag costs \$1.50 and a 15-gallon bag costs .75c

All resident locations currently in the municipal trash system will be billed an annual fee to provide revenue for contractual services. Senior citizens, living alone and 65 or older, will continue to receive a 50% reduction of their bill if they apply for a Senior Discount status.

CURBSIDE TRASH

ALL TRASH AND RECYCLABLES MUST BE PLACED CURBSIDE BY 7:00 A.M.

WHAT

- ▲ Normal Household Trash
- ▲ One large item free per week (for example: couch, chair, mattress) or carpeting, tied in 4' lengths.
- ▲ Alkaline Batteries may be disposed of in regular trash.

HOW TO PREPARE

- ▲ Place trash & recyclables out no later than 7:00 a.m.
- ▲ Place trash in yellow bags. Bags may be placed in trash receptacle.

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ▲ No recyclables with trash.
- ▲ No branches or yard waste.
- ▲ No tires, oil, paint or propane tanks.
- ▲ Do not exceed 3" above lip of a barrel. Barrel or bag must not be larger than 35 gallons or weigh over 50 lbs.

Anything metal / electrical / appliances / all gas powered items / car batteries / sliding glass doors and windows will be picked up weekly at the curb on Tuesdays. **APPOINTMENT REQUIRED. Call 1-800-248-8898 ext. 36 by Friday 3 PM to schedule an appointment.**



RECYCLABLES



Recycling bins can be purchased at the Towns Solid Waste/Recycling Center Office in Medway Town Hall for \$7.00 each

BIN #1 - PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Medway collects "mixed" paper, where all paper and cardboard is mixed and pulped together. It sells for less than "sorted" paper. However, this approach allows for more types of material to be collected and recycled. **Please remember to keep your paper separate from your co-mingled containers**

WHAT

- ▲ Newspaper, glossy inserts, magazines, phone books, junk mail, catalogs and all other white and color paper.
- ▲ Corrugated cardboard, paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.), pizza boxes, egg cartons, cardboard juice & milk containers.

HOW TO PREPARE

- ▲ Place all paper products in paper bags or (bundle and tie products) or place loose in bin (okay if raining).
- ▲ Remove all plastic and foil liners.
- ▲ Flatten & bundle cardboard into 3' by 3' by 1' or place in paper bags - not inside another box.
- ▲ Place in open bin or paper bag.



DO NOT INCLUDE

- ▲ No foil coated materials.
- ▲ No clothing or shoes.
- ▲ **Note:** Soiled paper towels, napkins, tissue, etc. can be composted in your back yard.
- ▲ Do not place in plastic bags.



BIN #2 - CO-MINGLED MATERIAL: GLASS, METAL/TIN CANS, ALUMINUM & PLASTIC CONTAINERS

WHAT

- ▲ Plastic milk, juice and water jugs, soda bottles, detergent bottles and other plastic bottles with a recycling symbol  
- ▲ No Styrofoam
- ▲ Glass (food & beverage containers)
- ▲ Metal/tin cans, aluminum cans, foil & pans, empty aerosol cans.



HOW TO PREPARE

- ▲ Please rinse clean.
- ▲ Labels may be left on.
- ▲ Remove lids (but recycle them also).
- ▲ Recyclables can be placed in any type of container clearly marked "Recyclables".

DO NOT INCLUDE

- ▲ No porcelain, ceramics, light bulbs, window glass or broken glass, dishes, glasses or mirrors.
- ▲ No oil base paint containers.
- ▲ No plastic toys or furniture.
- ▲ No plastic bags.
- ▲ No automotive product containers (antifreeze, oil, transmission fluid, etc.).
- ▲ No styrofoam packing peanuts.
- ▲ No plastic flower pots.

DISPOSAL OF LATEX PAINT

Latex paint can be disposed of by lining a cardboard box with plastic. Add kitty litter or sawdust, pour in a reasonable amount of paint, mix it, and let it dry. Once dried, lift out the plastic with the contents, and place it in with the regular trash in a yellow trash bag. Leave the lid off the paint can, let it dry out, and place it in next to your trash at the curb. **Oil-based paint** is an acceptable item at Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events.
