This information was sent to the buyers and they are still seeking \$15,000.00 for closing costs. Attorney Lee communicated that the documentation allows for a marketable title. The recommendation is to rescind the previous offer of \$10,000.00 and set a certain date for closing and if the buyer does not agree, the trust will terminate the purchase and sale agreement and will withhold all deposits as liquidated damages.
