Board Meeting Minutes

Date/Time of Meeting: Monday, February 10, 2020
Location of Meeting: Medway Public Library, 26 High Street, 1st floor

Called to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:31pm by Mr. Mill.

Agenda Item 1:

Mosquito Spraying
Norfolk County

Ms. Hallal opened up the meeting by bringing information about mosquito spraying in Norfolk County. She relayed information that aerial spraying for 2020 will be conducted between April 6th through October 31st, and passed around the memo from Norfolk County Mosquito Control outlining regulations and targeted locations.

Ms. Hallal presented that Mr. Proia was requesting new construction, noting that the originally accepted plans had specific wall, but the wall was being altered to a stone wall

The Board unanimously approved the request for a septic permit revision.

Other Items:

Corona Virus

Ms. Hallal dispersed documentation offered by DPH (Department of Public Health), asking the Board to review statistics.

The Board had an in-depth discussion about the percentage rate in China, US, world statistics, containment, and precautions being taken by the CDC and international airports. Ms. Hallal noted that influenza is still more dangerous in the US; effecting an average of 30,000 annually. Mr. Mill displayed concern surrounding Medway and an Emergency Dispensing Site (EDS). Ms. Hallal responded by elaborating on her emergency preparation training with Fire Chief Lynch, and what Medway would do in regards to precautions, containment, and casualties.
