Board Meeting Minutes

Committee Members Present: Michael Heavey, Jack Mill, Eric Lindstrom **Town Employees Present:** Beth Hallal, Kelly OBrien **Called to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 6:31pm by Mr. Mill. **Minutes Review:** Motion made by Mr. Mill to approve the minutes from January 21st and Mr. Heavey concurred. Agenda Item 1: Ms. Hallal opened up the meeting by bringing information about mosquito spraying in Norfolk County. She relayed information that Mosquito Spraying aerial spraving for 2020 will be conducted between April 6th through Norfolk County October 31st, and passed around the memo from Norfolk County Mosquito Control outlining regulations and targeted locations. Agenda Item 2: Permits from the following entities where reviewed and approved by Approval of Various the Board: Permits / Plans J & L Catering (Catering) Bossy's Catering (Catering) *Medway Country Manor (ratification of Food Establishment) Smith Septic (Septic Hauler)* Groundbreaking Excavation (Disposal Works) Agenda Item 3: Ms. Hallal presented that Mr. Proia was requesting new construction, Proposed New Construction noting that the originally accepted plans had specific wall, but the wall septic permit revision was being altered to a stone wall 54 West Street The Board unanimously approved the request for a septic permit Joseph Proia revision. **Other Items:** Ms. Hallal dispersed documentation offered by DPH (Department of Corona Virus Public Health), asking the Board to review statistics. Beth Hallal The Board had an in-depth discussion about the percentage rate in *China, US, world statistics, containment, and precautions being taken* by the CDC and international airports. Ms. Hallal noted that influenza is still more dangerous in the US; effecting an average of 30,000 annually. Mr. Mill displayed concern surrounding Medway and an Emergency Dispensing Site (EDS). Ms. Hallal responded by elaborating on her emergency preparation training with Fire Chief Lynch, and what Medway would do in regards to precautions, containment, and casualties.
