Subject: Septic System Repair

Subject: Arbovirus
Surveillance Program Report

Ms. Hallal spoke of the report received from DPH, noting that mosquito samples collected had EEE from Orange, MA (7/1), Carver MA (7/13), and Wendell, MA (7/5). The report states that mosquito surveillance will continue in Franklin and Plymouth counties and elaborates tips for prevention of EEE. Mr. Lindstrom recommended we look into putting bathhouses in Medway's wetlands near the parks and fields. Mr. Lindstrom also asked when Medway was spraying, and inquired about weekly sprays in these areas as well. Ms. Hallal stated that she would look into his requests and circle back to the Board.
