Call to Order: At 8:31AM, Ms. Rossi called the meeting to order.

Public Comments: There were none at this time.

Other Business: There was no other business at this time.

1. Choate and Oakland Communication Boards – Discussion/vote

Ms. Harrington noted that she sent pictures of the communication board to the commissioners. She shared that she has been working with Amy and Steve to install communication boards in the concrete at Choate and Oakland. It would be \$2,600 for each board, which does not include the cost of stickers; she estimated that it would nonetheless likely be less than \$3,500 per park once the cost of stickers are included. There will also be a cost for shipping. Therefore the total cost estimate is approximately \$8,000.

Mr. Core expressed concern about potential vandalism; Ms. Harrington noted that the location of the boards is within the video of surveillance cameras.

Ms. Rossi inquired as to whether the board will be tactile; Ms. Harrington clarified that it will not be tactile.

Mr. Murphy expressed concern about potential damage; Ms. Harrington stated that most damage can be superficially removed, but she offered to ask Megan about this. She expressed that there is likely not a warranty for the boards.

VOTE: Ms. Rossi offered a motion to approve up to \$8,000 for the purchase and installation of the aforementioned communication boards. Mr. Farrell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Rossi: aye, Farrell: aye, Murphy: aye, Core: aye. VOTE: 4-0.

Mr. D’Innocenzo recused himself from the above vote.

Motion to Adjourn: At 8:38AM, Ms. Rossi offered a motion to adjourn. Mr. Farrell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Rossi: aye, Farrell: aye, Murphy: aye, Core: aye. VOTE: 4-0.

Mr. D’Innocenzo recused himself from the above vote
