# **Approval of Invoices:**

On a motion made by Mr. Griffin, seconded by Mr. Stumpf, the MRA voted 5-0 to approve the invoice for Petersen LaChance Regan Pino in the amount of \$3,900.00.

## <u>Acquisition of land in Oak Grove Urban Renewal Area and award of \$100,000 Site</u> Readiness grant from state

Ms. Saint Andre stated that the grant is now official, and the MRA can use the funds for appraisals, due diligence, title work, and surveys. There may be a time frame within which the monies must be used. If the land acquired is later sold, the grant must be paid back from any excess funds. The members discussed using the funds toward acquisition of the Williams properties, and properties with frontage.

# <u>Discussion of progress on Route 109/Trotter Drive traffic signal including potential MPO assistance</u>

Mr. Yorkis stated that, once the study of the intersection is complete, we should apply in the next grant cycle for funding for the intersection. He noted that he observed some Mass. Highway personnel at the intersection last week doing some measurements.
