- D. Right to Farm By-Law- Members of the commission scanned the information provided by Ms. Dempsey at the last meeting. Ms. Perkins noted that the major point of obtaining Right to Farm status is to make the public aware that farming is supported by the community. Chairman Atwood will talk it over with someone at Town Hall to see what the likelihood is that the town is interested in pursuing this endeavor.
- E. Medway Public School Gardens- no update.
- F. Medway Pride Day- will be held May 19th. The Board will check into sharing a table with the Medway Community Farm.

New Business:

A. Chairman Atwood invited available Board members to participate in a baseline documentation workshop along with members of the Open Space Committee, which is taking place on May 5th, 2018 from 9-3 at the amphitheater. The baseline assessment will list the intended uses for the land, what it looks like presently as well as what modifications can be made to it in the future, and will allow for the receipt of conservation restrictions at the state level.
