COVID-19 Testing *Action Item: Ms. Hallal to look into benefits/costs/cost sharing with neighboring towns and report findings to BOH*

Discussion Items:

1. Resident Call Concerning Mask Mandate: Ms. Hallal informed BOH of call from resident in regard to mask mandate. Ms. Hallal explained to resident that the town of Medway is following state mandate and state advisory from DPH.
2. Town Covid Data: 59 positive cases 17 of which are in the age group 0-20; 13 of which are in the age group 21-40 and 27 of which are ages 40 and above.
3. Masks/tests: Medway has supply of masks. Medway is not on list to receive rapid tests as the state focus is on low income communities.

4. Action Item: Ms. Hallal to look into costs and availability of tests and if the town of Medway can use town money to purchase. Ms. Hallal to find out if DPW is grouped with first responders.
5. Progress on Seniors getting boosters: Ms. Tonelli provided update. Booster clinic took place.
