- Acquisition, creation, and preservation of open space;
- Acquisition and preservation of historical resources;
- Acquisition, creation, and preservation of land for recreational use;
- Creation, preservation, and support of community housing;
- Rehabilitation or restoration of such open space, historical property, recreational property, and community housing that is acquired or created.
