Andrews Survey & Engineering, Inc. ("ASE"), on behalf of our client Cheryl Rosenburg (the "Applicant"), makes a request to amend an existing Order of Conditions (OOC) approved for the above reference property.

The request for amendment is being made because of an oversight during permitting. An OOC was sought to cross the wetland with an open bottom box culvert. After the permit was obtained it was realized that the utilities were not shown on the plans. After speaking with the Medway DPW, it was determined how we could connect to the utilities necessary (water and sewer) for the project. A straightforward water connection is proposed. A sewer connection is proposed but since the roadway has been recently paved the applicant is not allowed to go into the street to make the sewer connection. An alternative solution has been worked out where the sewer will flow by gravity into a low pressure pumping station sized to handle flows from a single family dwelling. From the low pressure pump station, a force main will be installed and connected to a new sewer manhole within the right of way of Kelley St. The portion where the force main crosses the wetland and runs adjacent to the street will be installed by means of directional drilling minimizing the disturbance to the wetland.
