Dear Mr. Crawford,

Thank you for submitting the proposed signage for Ocean State Job Lot to the Medway Design Review Committee (DRC) for review. The information was filed with the Town on March 1, 2021.

Pursuant to the Medway Zoning Bylaw, SECTION 7.2 Sign Regulations, this communication serves as the DRC's review letter regarding the proposed new wall/façade sign for the expanded Ocean State Job Lot store at 114 Main Street in the Medway Place shopping plaza. Please be advised that this letter does NOT constitute approval of a sign permit. You must still apply for and secure a sign permit from the Medway Building Department prior to sign installation. Do not install the sign before obtaining the required permit.

On Monday, March 15, 2021, the DRC met with you and Tony Lafo of American Sign Inc. to review the proposed signage for the Ocean State Job Lot. You have proposed the following as represented on the sign designs submitted (**See Attached**).

• Wall/Façade Sign 48" x 22'6" (114 sq. ft.). This sign is comprised of internally illuminated channel letters and is replacing an existing sign. The letters and faces and trim caps will all be white.

The DRC offers the following comments/recommendations regarding the proposed sign:

- The DRC recommends that the applicant position the sign so it's more closely split between the two storefronts (former Condon's Hardware and current Job Lot).
- The applicant indicated that the Condon's Hardware and current Ocean State signs will be removed. The DRC recommends that any ghosting remaining after removal of those signs be painted over or cleaned before the new sign is installed.


