RE: DRC Sign Design Review Letter

Dear Mr. Murphy,

Thank you for submitting the designs for a wall sign and monument sign inset panels for Sean Murphy, CPA at 135 Main Street to the Medway Design Review Committee (DRC) for review. The information was filed with the Town on 6/12/17. The sign will be constructed and installed by Signs by Cam, of Franklin, MA.

Pursuant to the Medway Zoning Bylaw, SECTION 7.2 Sign Regulations, this communication serves as the DRC's review letter regarding the signage for Sean Murphy, CPA at 135 Main St, Medway, MA. Please be advised that this letter does NOT constitute the Town's approval of a sign permit. You must still apply for and secure a sign permit from the Medway Building Department prior to sign installation.

On Monday, June 19, 2017, the DRC met with your sign fabricator, Cam Afonso, to review the proposed signage as represented on the sign designs submitted and as attached:

- (2) Wall façade signs each measuring 2' x 8' overall for a total of 32 square feet are proposed, which is allowed by the Medway Sign Bylaw. The design is a rectangular sign with a maroon background and white letters outlined in black. It is in keeping of the style of the existing signs on the property.
- (2) sign panels for the current Monument Sign, measuring 12" x 32" per side for a total of 5.34 sq. feet. The panel will match the style of the façade sign; a rectangular sign with a maroon background and White letters outlined in black. It is in keeping of the style of the existing signs on the monument.

The DRC offers the following comments/recommendations regarding the proposed signage:

• The façade wall signs are legible and well designed. The DRC recommends that the spacing between the words 'bookkeeping', 'payroll', and 'Business Consulting' be increased or that the words be removed from the sign all together to improve legibility.

• Prior to installation of the wall façade sign, be sure that the façade is freshly painted to remove any fading or ghosting from the previous signage in that location.
