Collection limited to 25 gallons or 25 pounds per household

Due to COVID-19, additional precautions will be taken this year including:

Waste will only be accepted from pickup truck beds, trunks and the back of SUVs (we cannot accept any material from the seats of vehicles or materials handed to us from residents.)

Please remain in your vehicle at all times

We will not return any containers – (i.e. gas containers and storage totes, etc.)

We encourage residents to wear a mask

As always, please:

- Tighten caps and lids.
- Leave materials in their original labeled containers.
- Never mix chemicals. Mixtures can be dangerous as well as unidentifiable. Mixed materials will not be accepted.
- Pack all materials separately and carefully for transportation. Use sturdy, upright, and opened boxes and pack with newspaper.
- Sort and pack separately: paint, pesticides, and household cleaners.
- Avoid spills and do not place items in a garbage bag.
- Pack your vehicle and go directly to the site.
- Never smoke while handling hazardous material.
- Anyone bringing unaccepted materials to the collection site will be required to take these
 materials home. They cannot be left at the site.
