

## MEDWAY EPFRAC MEETING Medway High School (Guidance Area) 7:00 P.M. Minutes February 14, 2017

Committee Attendees: Dr. Richard D'Innocenzo, Mike Francis (Open Space), Paul Mahoney (CPC), Kary McCleod (Friends of Choate Park), David Travalini (CONCOM), Michael Schrader (FinCom).

Committee Chair Dr. D'Innocenzo called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM.

The final master plan (with preliminary cost estimate by area) was presented to CPC. Mr. D' Innocenzo stated that the town anticipates funding \$2.0 million and CPC \$1.5 - \$2.0 million towards this project. CPC requested EPFRAC to identify tasks that could utilize CPC funds. At this meeting, members went over the master plan cost estimate spreadsheets to identify tasks that are eligible to use CPC funds.

The sum total of the project is \$ 3.8 million with anticipated \$2.5 million from CPC funds and \$1.3 million from town funds. *All figures are estimates only.* 

Members agreed to request CPC to hold another joint meeting with BOS, EPFRAC, and CPC on March 13, 2017.

There was general discussion on selecting the qualified consultant to implement the project and also to include construction oversight into project cost.

During the discussion, Ms. McCleod suggested that the splash pad should be moved closer to the parking lot/ building to eliminate the need for pipes to be laid underneath the playground. This could also lead to some cost savings.

A motion was made by Mr. Mahoney to recommend \$3.8 million proposal (\$2.5 million-CPC funds, \$1.3 million- Town funds) to CPC {task(s) breakdown by area and funding source attached}, seconded by Mr. Travalini. It was voted 9-6-3 Unanimous.

A motion was made by Mr. Mahoney to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 PM, seconded by Mr. Francis. All were in favor.
