## A. Call to Order

B. Public Comment

- C. Medway Community Farm-Native American Powwow Saturday May 4<sup>th</sup> 11am Updates Ms. Crosby updated the Committee about the Powwow. Ms. Crosby reported things were moving along, but then The Farm started having some reservations about the people throwing the Powwow aligning with the views of Medway about indigenous people. Ms. Crosby spoke with Brittany Wally, who did not know who the people were that were throwing the Powwow. The group seemed to be part of a tribe that was not part of the indigenous people native to the area or even Massachusetts. Ms. Crosby reported The Farm put a stop to the event and gave the group time to get inclusion and/or the blessing from tribes in the area.

Ms. Hamilton informed the Committee about the place and designer the Historical Commission has used for their plaques. Ms. Hamilton questioned if Choate Park had any connection to indigenous people of the area. Ms. Crosby stated that any land in the area could be considered connected to indigenous people because it is known there were native tribes in the area and they traveled through what is known as the current Medway. Ms. Crosby suggested the idea of doing a plaque that doesn't have to be historically based, but connected to indigenous people of the area somehow, like a poem with a translation for example.

Ms. Phillips suggested going in front of the Selectboard to change the charter as the Committee has evolved and changed. The Committee discussed setting their goal as creating and installing historical and informative plaques and signs as well as building relationships with indigenous people and tribes still in the area.

Ms. Sullivan stated the members' appointments have expired, so they would all need to be reappointed.
