Ms. Venezia spoke to the idea that they are in the process of building relationships and alliances with the indigenous community that could result in some collaboration in coming years, but at this time Ms. Wally was not comfortable with speaking at an event.

- Utilizing 4 boxes on trails and at schools Mr. Trindade stated the first thing to do would be to make sure they are intact. Any issues can be taken care of by the town.
 - 1. Library Library will highlight authors and books available at the library.
 - 2. Trails- Identifying Native Plants, Mushrooms, Wildlife Mr. Trindade stated he would reach out to Jim at trails to assist with a box.

- 3. Jo-Ann/Liam Native use of land Ms. Venezia stated that maybe students would be interested and if not, her and Liam could take this on
- 4. The Historical Society could provide historical information rendered from last year's event.
- E. Brainstorm Facebook Page to help promote IPD events in Medway and larger Community

Ms. Venezia questioned if the Committee would like to have a social media page to promote local Indigenous People's Day celebrations and other information.
