This house was built some time between 1830 and 1852 and became known as the Philip Sparrow House. Some people in Medway may remember it as the "Cider Mill" since one of the outbuildings was used to make apple cider. The owners will try to incorporate the house into their plans for the property; the barn and outbuildings will be demolished.
