Ted Kenney makes a motion to open the Water/Sewer Commissioners meeting at 5:00 PM. Leo O'Rourke seconded, unanimous vote.

Abatement Requests:

Abatement Request -13 Williamsburg Way - Nanda Gopal Akarapu

The homeowner had a silent leak in a toilet located in the guest bathroom. An abatement was granted for the February bill. The leak crossed over two bills bill cycles. This is a water and sewer account. This portion of the leak represents approximately 1,814cf of lost water. If an abatement were granted the value would be approximately \$221.31. The breakdown is as follows: \$122.63 for water and \$98.68 for sewer. Half of the value would is \$110.66. The breakdown is \$61.32 for water and \$49.34 for sewer **Leo O'Rourke made a motion to approve the abatement as written above. Ted Kenney seconded the motion. Unanimous.**

Directors Report:

Mr. Smith informed the Commissioners that he attended a demonstration for Aquahawk, which is a software reporting system similar to the Water Smart technology. The costs associated with the software are as follows: Year 1 approximately \$18,000.00, Year 2 \$9,000.00. He is planning to hold a demonstration for the Commissioners in the near future.

Mr. Smith informed the Commissioners that we are still performing leak detection. We continue to bring our unaccounted for water numbers down.

Open Discussion:

The Commissioners discussed the fee schedule that was update on May 15, 2017. They specifically discussed the need for the Emergency Final Bill fee of \$80.00 for final bills that are needed within 24 hours of the request.

Ted Kenney makes a motion to approve the new fee. Leo O'Rourke seconded the motion. Unanimous.

The next meeting is scheduled for August 21, 2017 at 5PM. The meeting will be held in the DPS Conference Room, 45B Holliston Street, Door 9, Medway, MA.
