All trash and recyclables **MUST** be placed curbside by **7:00AM**. Recycling will not be picked up if it is outside the Town issued recycle cart and the lid is not completely closed. All households in the municipal trash and recycling program will be billed an annual fee of \$250 to provide basic solid waste and recycling services. Additional carts may be requested (\$60/year/cart). Please remember that carts are the property of the Town and must remain at the address to which they were distributed. Damaged carts can be repaired by appointment, call 508-533-3275. Residents participating in the trash and recycling program have access to the Town's Recycling Center. The blue Recycling Center stickers will expire on 7/1/20. The Town is issuing new **ORANGE** Recycling Center stickers, which can be picked up at the Recycling Center during normal operating hours. A second sticker can be purchased at the Recycling Center for \$15. **To find your Curbside Collection day**, use the Trash & Recycling link at <u>www.townofmedway.org</u>. Medway operates a "Pay-As-You-Throw" system of trash collection every week. A 30-gallon bag costs \$1.50 and 15-gallon bag costs \$0.75 (sold in packs of five). Only trash in specially printed yellow Medway trash bags will be collected curbside.
