All trash and recyclables **MUST** be placed curbside by **7:00AM**. All households in the municipal trash and recycling program will be billed an annual fee of \$250 to provide basic solid waste and recycling services. Additional carts may be requested (\$60/year/cart). Please remember that carts are the property of the Town and must remain at the address to which they were distributed. Damaged carts can be repaired by appointment, call 508-533-3275. Residents participating in the trash and recycling program have access to the Town's Recycling Center. **Please keep your existing sticker.** A second sticker can be purchased at the Recycling Center for \$15. - Christmas tree pickup – January 10 - 14 (on your trash day). Please ensure all decorations, lights, etc. are removed.
- Household Hazardous Waste Day (HHWD)** will be held on November 20, 2021 and May 14, 2022 from 9am-1pm. For a list of acceptable materials and location information please visit the DPW page at [www.townofmedway.org](http://www.townofmedway.org).
- Special Item Curbside Pickup** Every Tuesday we accept "Special Items" including white goods, large metal items, and large bulk items. Limited to a total of 4 of these items per year. **Appointments are required, please call 1-508-533-5200** to schedule. White goods = A/C units, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, water heaters, and trash compactors. Large metal items = grills, file cabinets, lawn mowers, snow blowers, etc. (fuels emptied). Large "bulk items" = burnable items over 6' long and/or over 100 lbs. (i.e. couches, mattresses, doors, large furniture, etc.). If you exceed the 4 item limit for curbside pickup, you may bring items to the Recycling Center or contact a private hauler. Additional fees may apply.

## Curbside Recycling Quick Guide List

## CURBSIDE SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Medway collects **single stream recycling weekly** in a 96-gallon wheeled cart. Recycling will not be picked up if it is outside the Town issued recycle cart and the lid is not completely closed.

ACCEPTED ITEMS	HOW TO PREPARE	DO NOT INCLUDE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Mixed Paper: newspaper, paper bags, magazines, phone books, junk mail, catalogs etc.</li> <li> Cardboard: clean cardboard and paperboard, egg cartons etc.</li> <li> Plastic: jars, jugs, tubs, and bottles (with lids).</li> <li> Glass: bottles and jars (clean and not broken).</li> <li> Metal: food and beverage cans.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Keep the cart lid closed to keep rain, snow, and animals out. Wet material is a contaminant.</li> <li> Flatten cardboard to fit into cart loosely.</li> <li> Remove all plastic or foil liners.</li> <li> <u>Empty and rinse containers clean.</u></li> <li> Carts must be placed 3' apart from each other and any other objects. Arrows on lid point toward the street.</li> <li> To move the cart, use the handle to tilt it on its wheels to roll it.</li> <li> Clean your cart periodically.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>No foam plastics:</b> Styrofoam cups, packaging material, food containers, etc. (trash).</li> <li> <b>No rigid plastics:</b> toys, laundry bins etc. (trash or bring to the Recycling Center).</li> <li> <b>No hazardous material</b> (Bi-annual HHWD).</li> <li> <b>No small appliances</b> (trash, donate, or bring to the Recycling Center).</li> <li> <b>No porcelain, ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, broken glass, mirrors</b> (trash).</li> <li> <b>No paper towels, napkins, tissues, paper plates, etc.</b> (compost or trash).</li> <li> <b>No cartons:</b> cream/milk containers etc. (trash).</li> <li> <b>No frozen food paperboard containers</b> (trash).</li> <li> <b>No black plastics:</b> take out containers etc. (trash).</li> </ul>

## CURBSIDE TRASH

Medway operates a "Pay-As-You-Throw" system of trash collection every week. A 30-gallon bag costs \$1.50 and 15-gallon bag costs \$0.75 (sold in packs of five). **Only trash in specially printed yellow Medway trash bags will be collected curbside.** Purchase bags here:

ACCEPTED ITEMS	HOW TO PREPARE	DO NOT INCLUDE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Normal household trash.</li> <li> Tissues, paper towels, napkins etc.</li> <li> Latex paint/water-based coatings (dried out with kitty litter or sand).</li> <li> Alkaline batteries.</li> <li> Smoke detectors.</li> <li> <b>Small appliances:</b> toasters, microwaves, coffee makers, etc. are considered trash. Place in yellow bags. Alternatively, residents can donate working items or bring items to the Recycling Center.</li> <li> <b>Small Bulk item:</b> <u>1 item</u> free per week (chair, carpet rolled in 4' lengths, toilet, sink, window, etc.). As listed or burnable, and shorter than 6' and less than 100 lbs.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Place trash out no later than 7:00 AM.</li> <li> Place trash in yellow bags, tied.</li> <li> Bags may be placed in trash receptacle no larger than 35 gal or weigh over 40 lbs. Do not exceed 3" above lip of barrel.</li> <li> Barrels cannot have an attached lid. Only a detachable lid is allowed.</li> <li> Leave at the edge of your property close to the roadway but not in the street or sidewalk.</li> <li> <b>Make an appointment for Special Item Pickup.</b> Limited to 4 items total per year. Call: <b>1-508-533-5200</b> by Friday at noon to schedule a pickup for the following Tuesday.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> No recyclables mixed with trash.</li> <li> No yard waste (bring to Recycling Center).</li> <li> No construction materials: shingles, bricks, lumber, wallboard, insulation, cement etc. (contact a private hauler).</li> <li> No tires, car batteries, propane tanks, or fire extinguishers (return to store or bring to Recycling Center).</li> <li> <b>No hazardous material.</b> See calendar for bi-annual HHWDs.</li> <li> <b>No electronics</b> (bring to Recycling Center).</li> <li> <b>No medical sharps or prescription medication.</b> Dispose at the Medway Police Station (315 Village Street).</li> <li> <b>No rechargeable, lithium, or button cell batteries. NO items containing mercury.</b> (Bring to Recycling Center).</li> </ul>

## BROAD STREET RECYCLING CENTER: 46 BROAD STREET

Open to Medway residents participating in the Town's trash and recycling program with a valid sticker (see front for details). Stickers must be permanently affixed to your vehicle. No commercial vehicles allowed without DPW special permit. For businesses or condos utilizing private trash service we offer a "Recycling Only" sticker for \$60 and \$30 respectively per fiscal year (no trash, bulk, yard waste, or tires).

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Single stream recycling:</b> unsorted (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Mixed paper or cardboard:</b> separated &amp; clean (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Rigid plastic:</b> coolers, crates, toys, etc. (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Clothing/textiles bin:</b> (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Book bin:</b> (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Medway Lions Club bottles and cans</b> donations (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Swap Shop:</b> only reusable items (Town's discretion).</li> <li> <b>Foam:</b> coolers, packing blocks, white insulation board ONLY (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Mercury bulbs and thermometers</b> (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Batteries:</b> rechargeable, button cell, and lithium (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Yard waste:</b> grass, leaves, brush, logs under 12" wide and 1'-4' long- <u>no pine</u> (FREE). Compost available for free (self-load).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Metal appliances:</b> fuels/oils emptied (FREE).</li> <li> <b>White goods</b> (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Propane/helium tanks</b> (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Electronics</b> (FREE).</li> <li> <b>Mattresses and/or box springs</b> (\$15 each).</li> <li> <b>Bulk items:</b> wooden furniture, upholstered furniture, rugs, (\$15/Cubic Yard).</li> <li> <b>Tires:</b> passenger/Lt truck only (remove rims) (\$3/each).</li> </ul> <p><b>NO</b> packing peanuts, food containers, pink/blue insulation board.  <b>NO</b> construction/renovation materials (shingles, bricks, wallboard, insulation, cement, tiles, flooring, siding, doors, windows, etc.).
