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SECTION 00020 TOWN OF MEDWAY INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for **PAVING**, **MILLING**, **RECLAIM and CASTING ADJUSTMENTS** will be received at the Office of the Department of Public Works, 45B Holliston Street, Door #9, Medway, MA 02053 until the time specified below at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read.

"MassDOT prequalification of contractors with the class of work as, PAVEMENT SURFACING (OPTIONS CONTRACT), for the project with an estimated value of \$4,017,480 will be required.".

This contract is for a term of two years. No price increases will be accepted over the term of this contract. An option to extend for a third year if accepted at same unit pricing at time of contract extension.

Specifications, Scope of Work and bid forms may be obtained at the Office of Public Works, Monday through Thursday between 8 a.m. and 4:30 pm or email <u>bmcgee@townofmedway.org</u>, or Town of Medway Website, <u>www.townofmedway.org</u> find it fast, RFP/IFB.

Bids will be opened in the Office of the Public Works on **January 13, 2022**, at 10 a.m. Each Bid must be accompanied by a bid security consisting of a <u>BID BOND, CASH</u>, or, <u>CERTIFIED CHECK</u> issued by a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of 5% of the bid price (per year). DCAMM Certificate

Performance Bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total amount of the contract price (per year) with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be required for the faithful performance of the contract, as well as a labor and materials Payment Bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total contract price (per year).

Minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Labor and Workforce Development and the weekly payroll record submittal requirements.

Selection of the contractor will be based upon bidder qualifications, including evidence of past performance in similar projects, and bid price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder deemed by the awarding authority to be the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

The Town reserves the right to waive any informalities, to accept or reject, in whole or in part any or all bids, or take whatever other action may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.

This contract is for a term of two years. No price increases will be accepted over the term of this contract. An option to extend for a third year if accepted at same unit pricing at time of contract extension.

No Pre-Bid Conference and No Site Visit required.

A Performance Bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total amount of the contract price (per year) with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be required for the faithful performance of the contract, as well as a labor and materials Payment Bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total contract price (per year).

All bids for this project are subject to applicable public bidding laws of Massachusetts, including, but not limited to G.L. c.30, section 39M, as amended.

Minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development and the weekly payroll record submittal requirements under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 through 27D inclusive.

Selection of the contractor will be based upon bidder qualifications, including evidence of past performance in similar projects, and bid price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder deemed by the awarding authority to be the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids.

The Town reserves the right to waive any informalities, to accept or reject, in whole or in part any or all bids, or take whatever other action may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.

SECTION 00100 INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. <u>Receipt and Opening of Bids</u>

The Town of Medway, Massachusetts, herein called the Town, acting by and through its Board of Selectmen, will receive sealed Bids for the project known as the **PAVING, MILLING RECLAIM and CASTING ADJUSTMENTS** Project.

General bids shall be addressed to the Department of Public Works, 45B Holliston St., Medway, MA 02053 and endorsed "Bid for **PAVING**, **MILLING RECLAIM and CASTING ADJUSTMENTS** Project" (Project) will be received at the Office of the Public Works until 10:00 a.m. prevailing time, on **Thursday**, **January 13**, **2022** at which time and place said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified will not be considered. The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of bids.

2. Location and Work to be Done

The Work consists of **PAVING**, **MILLING RECLAIM and CASTING ADJUSTMENTS** and all work incidental thereto, in accordance with the Specifications and conceptual plans. Additional Scope of Work may be furnished by addendum from time to time during the bidding period by the Town and shall then become a part of the Contract Documents.

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, services, equipment, plant, machinery, apparatus, appliances, tools, supplies, and all other things necessary to do all work required for the completion of each item of the Work and as herein specified. The Work to be done and paid for under any item shall not be limited to the exact extent mentioned or described but shall include all incidental work necessary or customarily done for the completion of that item.

3. <u>Preparation of Bid</u>

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, his address, and endorsed with the name of the project as specified in <u>Receipt and Opening of Bids</u>, above. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed as specified in <u>Receipt and Opening of Bids</u>, above.

4. <u>Bid Opening Procedure</u>

The following list of requirements shall apply to each filed bid. Bids not meeting all the requirements for timeliness and security will be rejected; bids not meeting signature and addenda requirements will be rejected prior to checking of bid amounts.

Properly executed bid security shall be placed in a sealed envelope and <u>shall be attached to</u> the outside of the envelope containing the bid. Bid signatures will be checked.

All addenda will be sent by E-Mail, with return receipt requested, to all prospective bidders. All bidders shall include with their bids the written acknowledgment form provided in Section 00300, FORM OF GENERAL BID.

The total dollar amount of each bid will be read, and the three apparent lowest bids will be selected for further consideration. These three apparent low bids will be read aloud for the benefit of the other bidders and the bid opening procedure will be closed. All those present at the bid opening may examine all bids after the bid opening and after the reading of the three apparent low bids.

5. <u>Modification</u>

Any bidder may modify his bid by written communication at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids. Any telegraphic communication must be received by the Town prior to the closing time, and, provided further, the Town must be satisfied that a written confirmation of the telegraphic modification over the signature of the bidder was mailed prior to the closing time. If written confirmation is not received within two days from the closing time, no consideration will be given to a telegraphic communication.

The communication shall not reveal the bid price but shall provide the addition or subtraction or other modification so that the final prices or terms will not be known by the Town until the sealed bid is opened.

6. <u>Ability and Experience of Bidder</u>

No award will be made to any bidder who cannot satisfy the Town that he has sufficient ability and experience in this class of work and sufficient capital and plant to enable him to prosecute and complete the work successfully within the time named. The Town's decision or judgment on these matters will be final, conclusive, and binding.

The Town may make such investigations as it deems necessary, and the bidder shall furnish to the Town, under oath if so required, all such information and data for this purpose as the Town may request.

7. <u>Conditions of Work</u>

Each bidder must familiarize himself fully with the conditions relating to the construction of the project and the employment of labor thereon. Failure to do so will not relieve a successful bidder of his obligation to furnish all material and labor necessary to carry out the provisions of his contract. Insofar as possible the Contractor, in carrying out his work, must employ such methods or means as will not cause any interruption of or interference with the work of any other Contractor.

8. <u>Addenda and Interpretations</u>

No interpretation of the meaning of the plans, specifications or other prebid documents will be made to any bidder orally. All information given to bidders other than by means of the plans, specifications, or by addenda, as described below, is given informally and shall not be used as the basis of a claim against the Town.

Every request for such interpretation should be in writing addressed to Bobby McGee, Department of Public Works, 45B Holliston Street, Door #9, Medway, MA 02053, or Email **bmcgee@townofmedway.org** and to be given consideration must be received at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be in form of written addenda to the specifications which, when issued, will be E-Mailed to all prospective bidders (at the respective address furnished by them for such purposes). Failure of any bidder to receive any such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve such bidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted. All addenda so issued shall become part of the Contract Documents.

9. <u>Security for Faithful Performance and Payment Bond</u>

Simultaneously with his delivery of the executed Contract, the Contractor shall furnish a surety bond or bonds as security for faithful **Performance** of this contract and for the **Payment** of all persons performing labor and materials under this contract. The surety on such bond or bonds shall be a surety company qualified to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth and satisfactory to the Town. The bonds shall remain in force for one year after final acceptance of the work by the Town, unless the Town, in writing, releases the Contractor from the obligation sooner.

10. <u>Power of Attorney</u>

Attorneys-in-fact who sign Contract bonds must file with each bond a certified and effectively dated copy of their power of attorney.

11. Laws and Regulations

The bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable State laws, municipal ordinances or bylaws, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall

apply to the contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the Contract the same as though written out in full.

12. Information Not Guaranteed

All information given in the Contract Documents relating to subsurface and other conditions, natural phenomena, existing pipes, and other structures is from the best sources at present available to the Town. All such information furnished only for the information and convenience of bidders and is not guaranteed.

It is agreed and understood that the Town does not warrant or guarantee that the subsurface or other conditions, natural phenomena, existing pipes, or other structures encountered during construction will be the same as those indicated in the Contract Documents. It is further agreed and understood that no bidder or Contractor shall use or be entitled to use any of the information made available to him or obtained in any examination made by him in any manner as a basis of or ground for any claim or demand against the Town, arising from or by reason of any variance which may exist between the information made available and the actual subsurface or other structures actually encountered during the construction work, except as may otherwise be expressly provided for in the Contract Documents.

13. <u>Bid Security</u>

Each bid and sub-bid must be accompanied by bid security in the form of a certified check, a bid bond, cash, or a treasurer's or cashier's check, payable to the Town, in the amount of five (5) percent of the value of the bid. Such security of general bidders will be returned to all except the three lowest responsible and eligible bidders within five days, Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of bids, and the remaining securities will be returned promptly after the Town and the accepted bidder have executed the Contract, or if no notice of intent to award has been presented to the selected contractor within 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays excluded, after the date of the opening of bids, upon demand of the bidder at any time thereafter.

14. <u>Right to Reject Bid</u>

The Town reserves the right to waive any informalities in bids and to reject any and all bids, should the Town deem it to be in the public interest to do so.

The Town may also reject bids which in its sole judgment are either incomplete, conditional, obscure or not responsive or which contain additions not called for, erasures not properly initialed, alterations, or similar irregularities.

15. <u>Time for Completion</u>

The successful general bidder must agree to commence work within ten (10) days of the date of the Notice to Proceed and to fully complete the project within the time limit.

16. <u>Comparison of Bids</u>

Bids will be compared on the basis of prices set forth in the bid forms. In the event that there is a discrepancy between the lump sum or unit prices written in words and figures, the prices written in words will govern.

17. <u>Award of Contract</u>

The Contract will be awarded to "the lowest responsible and eligible bidder" pursuant to General Laws 30, Section 39M), as amended. Such a bidder shall possess the skill, ability and integrity necessary for the faithful performance of the work, shall be able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed, or to be employed, in the work, and shall otherwise comply with all applicable provisions of law. Contract award shall be subject to availability of an appropriation for funding.

18. <u>Statutes Regulating Competitive Bidding</u>

Any bid which does not comply with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M, as amended, need not be accepted and the Town may reject every such bid.

19. <u>Wage Rates</u>

Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Labor and Workforce Development under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27G, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the bidder, before bid opening, to request any additional information on Prevailing Wage Rates for those tradespeople who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract. All subcontractors must submit weekly certified payroll reports for all staff.

20. <u>Contractor Records</u>

The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30, Section 39R concerning Contractor records.

21. INSURANCE

The Contractor shall carry and continuously maintain until completion of the Contract, insurance as specified in Agreement and in such form as shall protect him performing work covered by this Contract, and the Town and its employees, agents and officials, from all claims a liability for damages for bodily injury, including accidental death, and for property damage, which may arise from operations under this Contract. The **Town shall be named as an additional insured**. The Contractor covenants and agrees to hold the Town and its employees, agents and officials harmless from loss or damage due to claims for bodily injury or death and/or property damage arising from, or in connection with, operations under this Contract.

22. PROJECT MANAGER

The Town may utilize the services of a project manager, whose duties shall be as set forth in an Agreement for Project Manager Services.

23. <u>SCHEDULING AND PENALTIES</u>

Due to the disruptive nature of this work and concerns for public safety to Town residents, Town staff, and commuters, scheduling of work and adherence to schedule are vitally important. The successful bidder recognizes this fact and commits to the following additional terms:

- a. The Contractor shall provide a contact number to be used by the Town of Medway Representative or his designee to schedule work releases. The Town shall use this number Monday through Friday, 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. The Contractor shall respond within 36 hours to the Representative or his designee (excluding Sundays).
- b. The Contractor agrees to schedule work within a 30 day period from the time of a scheduling call from the Town unless an alternate time is selected by mutual agreement.
- c. The Contractor agrees to mobilize and be ready for work as scheduled for any given work release. . The Contractor agrees to compensate the Town for all preparation work associated with the work release including crew time, equipment, and police details as appropriate for any no show/no notification.
- 24. The Town recognizes the need to re-schedule work from time to time due to weather and other unforeseen conditions. The Contractor shall notify the Representative or his designee of a need to reschedule work at least 36 hours in advance of the scheduled time (excluding Sundays). Work to be rescheduled must be completed within 14 days of the original schedule. Work will not be allowed to be rescheduled more than one time unless mutually agreed to by the Town.

THIS AGREEMENT for PAVING, MILLING, RECLAIM, Casting Adjustments

(hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), made this _____ day of _____, in the year 2022, between (Contractor) _____, with a usual place of business at (Address) _____, hereinafter called the CONTRACTOR, and

the Town of Medway, acting by its Board of Selectmen, with a usual place of business at 155 Village Street, Medway, MA 02053, hereinafter called the Town.

The CONTRACTOR and the Town, for the consideration hereinafter named, agree as follows: TERMS OF AGREEMENT

This service agreement is effective as of the date of execution by ALL Parties and shall remain in effect for 2 years from the date of contract execution. With an option at the Town's sole discretion to extend for a third year as specified in the bid form

The CONTRACTOR agrees that the contract shall expire on March 31, 2024 unless both parties agree to a contract extension.

The CONTRACTOR agrees not to discriminate against or exclude any person from participation herein on grounds of race, religion, color, sex, age or national origin; and that it shall take affirmative actions to insure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during their employment, without regard to race, religion, color, sex, age, handicapped status, or national origin.

1. Scope of Work

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment and insurance to perform all work required for the project known as the **PAVING**, **MILLING**, **RECLAIM**, **Casting Adjustments** Project, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents and all related Drawings and Specifications. The said Documents, Specifications, Drawings and any supplemental general conditions are incorporated herein by reference and are made a part of this Agreement.

2. <u>Contract Price</u>

The TOWN shall pay the CONTRACTOR for the performance of this Agreement on a per unit basis per Contractor's proposal. Services to be ordered by individual release by authorized personnel only. Quantities may vary. Total Contract amount shall **not exceed** ______). Per year, for two years. With one year option.

3. <u>Commencement and Completion of Work</u>

It is agreed that time is of the essence of this Agreement. The Contractor shall commence and prosecute the work under this Agreement upon execution hereof and shall complete the work on a timely manner.

A. Progress and Completion: Contractor shall commence work promptly upon execution of this Agreement and shall prosecute and complete the work regularly, diligently and uninterruptedly at such a rate of progress as will insure Completion within the stipulated number of calendar days.

4. <u>Performance of the Work</u>

A. Direction of the Work: The Contractor shall supervise and direct the Work, using his best skills and attention which shall not be less than such state of skill and attention generally rendered by the contracting profession for projects similar to the Project in scope, difficulty and location. The Contractor shall maintain adequate supervisory personnel at the project site during the performance of the Work. He shall be solely responsible for all construction means, methods, techniques, sequences and procedures and for coordinating all portions of the Work under the Agreement.

B. Responsibility for the Work:

(1) The Contractor shall be responsible to the Town for the acts and omissions of his employees, Subcontractors and their agents and employees, and other persons performing any of the Work under a contract with the Contractor. This obligation shall also extend to the presence on the Site of suppliers of materials or equipment, their employees, contractors, and agents engaged in the work.

(2) The Contractor shall not be relieved from his obligations to perform the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents either by the activities or duties of the Town in its administration of the Agreement, or by inspections, tests or approvals required or performed by persons other than the Contractor.

- C. Permits and Fees: Unless otherwise expressly provided, the Contractor shall secure and pay for all permits and fees, licenses and inspections necessary for the proper execution and completion of the Work which are customarily secured after execution of the Agreement and which are legally required at the time the bids are received, and the same shall at all times be the property of the Town and shall be delivered to the Town upon completion of the Project.
- D. Notices, Compliance With Laws: (1) The Contractor shall give all notices and comply with all federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and lawful orders of any public authority bearing on the performance of the Work. The Contractor shall provide the Town with reproductions of all permits, licenses and receipts for any fees paid. The Town represents that it has disclosed to the Contractor all orders and requirements known to the Town of any public authority particular to this Agreement.

(2) If the Contractor observes that any of the Contract Documents are at variance with applicable laws, statutes, codes and regulations in any respect, he shall promptly notify the Town in writing, and any necessary changes shall be accomplished by appropriate modification.

(3) If the Contractor performs any Work which he knows or should know is contrary to such laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, and without such notice to the Town, he shall assume full responsibility therefor and shall bear all costs attributable thereto.

(4) In the performance of the Work, the Contractor shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations including those relating to workplace and employee safety. The Contractor shall notify the Town immediately of any conditions at

the place of the work which violate said laws and regulations and shall take prompt action to correct and eliminate any such violations.

- E. Project Superintendent: The Contractor shall employ a competent superintendent and necessary assistants who shall be in attendance at the Project site at all times during the progress of the Work. The superintendent shall represent the Contractor and all communications given to the superintendent shall be as binding as if given to the Contractor. Important communications shall be confirmed in writing. Other communications shall be so confirmed on written request in each case.
- F. Progress Schedule: The Contractor, immediately after being awarded the Contract, shall prepare and submit for the Town's information an estimated progress schedule for the Work. The progress schedule shall be related to the entire Project to the extent required by the Contract Documents, and shall provide for expeditious and practicable execution of the Work.
- G. Protection of the Work and Town's Property: The Contractor shall at all times safely guard the Town's property from injury or loss in connection with this Agreement. He shall at all times safely guard and protect his own work, and that of adjacent property from damage. The Contractor shall replace or make good any such damage, loss or injury. The Contractor shall clean the work area and restore it to its original condition upon completion of the work.
- H. Quality of the Work: The Contractor shall perform the work in a good, workmanlike manner. The Contractor hereby guarantees that the entire work constructed by him under the Agreement will meet fully all requirements thereof as to quality of workmanship and materials. The Contractor hereby agrees to make at his own expense any repairs or replacements made necessary by defects in materials or workmanship supplied to him that become evident within one (1) year after the date of the final payment, and to restore to full compliance with the requirements set forth herein any part of the work constructed hereunder, which during said one (1) year period is found to be deficient with respect to any provisions of the Contract Documents. The Contractor also agrees to hold the Town harmless from claims of any kind arising from damage due to said defects. The Contractor shall make all repairs and replacements promptly upon receipt of written orders for same from the Town. If the Contractor fails to make the repairs and replacements promptly, the Town may do the work and the Contractor shall be liable to the Town for the cost thereof.
- I. Warranty: The Contractor guarantees to Town that all materials incorporated into the work will be new unless otherwise specified or agreed. Prior to final payment, the Contractor shall deliver to the Town all manufacturers' warranties, together with such endorsements or assignments as are necessary to ensure to the Town the full rights and benefits of such warranties.
- 5. Affirmative Action/Equal Employment Opportunity

The Contractor is directed to comply with all applicable State Laws, Ordinances, Bylaws, and rules and regulations regarding affirmative action/equal employment opportunity

requirements. Failure of the Contractor to comply with any such law, rule or regulation shall constitute grounds for the Owner to terminate the Agreement.

6. <u>Site Information Not Guaranteed; Contractor's Investigation</u>

All information given in the Contract Documents relating to subsurface and other conditions, natural phenomena, existing pipes, and other structures is from the best sources at present available to the Town. All such information is furnished only for the information and convenience of the Contractor and is not guaranteed.

It is agreed and understood that the Town does not warrant or guarantee that the subsurface or other conditions, natural phenomena, existing pipes, or other structures encountered during construction will be the same as those indicated in the Contract Documents.

Contractor has familiarized himself with the nature and extent of the Contract Documents, work, locality, and with all local conditions and federal, state, and local laws, rules, ordinances, and regulations that in any manner may affect costs, progress, or performance of the work. Contractor has made, or has caused to be made, examinations, investigations, and tests and studies of such reports and related data in addition to those referred to in the paragraph above as he deems necessary for the performance of the work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Time, and in accordance with the other Terms and Conditions of the Contract Documents; and no additional examinations, tests, investigations, reports, and similar data are or will be required by the Contractor for such purposes.

Contractor has correlated the results of all such observations, examinations, investigations, tests, reports, and data with the Contract Documents. Contractor has given the Town written notice of all conflicts, errors, or discrepancies that he has discovered in the Contract Documents, and the resolution thereof by the Town is acceptable to the Contractor.

It is further agreed and understood that the Contractor shall not use or be entitled to use any of the information made available to him or obtained in any examination made by him in any manner as a basis of or ground for any claim or demand against the Town, arising from or by reason of any variance which may exist between the information made available and the actual subsurface conditions or other conditions or structures actually encountered during the construction work, except as may otherwise be expressly provided for in the Contract Documents.

- 7. <u>Project Architect or Engineer -</u> There is not a project architect-engineer for this project
- 8. <u>Wage Rates</u>

Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27G, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to provide the Town with certified payrolls and to comply with all requirements of the above-cited statutes.

The schedules of prevailing wage rates are included in the Contract Documents.

9. <u>Payments to the Contractor</u>

Within Thirty (30) days after receipt from the Contractor of a proper and satisfactory periodic estimate requesting payment of the amount due for the preceding month, the Town shall have Thirty (30) days to make payment for:

- A. The work performed during the preceding month.
- B. The materials not incorporated in the Work but delivered and suitably stored at the site (or at some location agreed upon in writing) to which the Contractor has title, or to which a Subcontractor has title and has authorized the Contractor to transfer title to the Town.
- C. Less the following retention items:
 - 1. A retention based on an estimate of the fair value of the Town's claims against the Contractor.
 - 2. A retention for direct payments to Subcontractors, if any, based on demands for same in accordance with the provisions of Section 39F of Chapter 30 of the General Laws.
 - 3. A retention not exceeding five percent (5%) of the approved amount of the periodic payment.
 - 4. All Permits must be closed out and Inspected by Town.
- D. After the receipt of a periodic estimate requesting final payment and within sixty-five (65) days after the Contractor fully completes the Work, or substantially completes the Work so that the value of the Work remaining to be done is, on the estimate of the Town, less than 1% of the original Contract Price, or substantially completes the Work and the Town takes possession, the Town shall pay the Contractor the entire balance due on the Contract less:
 - 1. A retention based on an estimate of the fair value of the Town's claims against the Contractor and of the cost of completing the incomplete and unsatisfactory items of work.
 - 2. A retention for direct payments to Subcontractors, if any, based on demands of same in accordance with the provisions of Section 39F of Chapter 30 of the General Laws, or based on the record of payments by the Contractor to the Subcontractors under this Contract if such record of payment indicates that the Contractor has not paid Subcontractors as provided in Section 39F of Chapter 30 of the General Laws.

If the Town fails to make payment as herein provided, there shall be added to each such payment, daily interest at the rate of 3 percentage points above the rediscount rate than charged by the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston, commencing on the first day after said payment is due, and continuing until the payment is delivered or mailed to the Contractor; provided that no interest shall be due, in any event, on the amount of a periodic estimate for final payment until fifteen (15) days after receipt of such a periodic estimate by the Town as provided in the first paragraph of this Article. The Contractor agrees to pay to each subcontractor a portion of any such interest paid in accordance with the amount due each subcontractor.

The Town may make changes in any periodic estimate submitted by the Contractor and the payment due on said periodic estimate shall be computed in accordance with the changes so made, and such changes and any requirements for a corrected periodic estimate shall not affect the due date for the periodic payment or the date for the commencement of interest charges on the amount of the periodic payment computed in accordance with the changes made, as provided herein; provided further, that the Town may, within seven (7) days after receipt, return to the Contractor for correction, any periodic estimate which is not in acceptable form or which contains computations not arithmetically correct, and in that event, the date of receipt of such periodic estimate shall be the date of receipt of the corrected periodic estimate in proper form and with arithmetically correct computations. The date of receipt of a periodic estimate received on a Saturday shall be the first working day thereafter.

- E. Changes in the Work: No changes in the work covered by the approved Contract Documents shall be made without prior written approval of the Town. Charges or credits for the work covered by the approved change shall be determined.
- F. Claims for Additional Costs: If the Contractor wishes to make a claim for an increase in the Contract Sum, he shall give the Town written notice thereof within twenty days after the occurrence of the event giving rise to such claim. This notice shall be given by the Contractor before proceeding to execute the Work, except in an emergency endangering life or property. No such claim shall be valid unless so made. Any change in the Contract Sum resulting from such claim shall be authorized by Change Order.

The Contractor hereby agrees that the Contractor shall have no claim for damages of any kind against the Town on account of any delay in the commencement or performance of the work and/or any hindrance, delay or suspension of any portion of the work including, but not limited to, any claims or damages on account of having to perform out of sequence work, claims for damages on account of loss of production or other interference with the work whether such delay is caused by the Town or otherwise, except as and to the extent expressly provided under G.L. c.30, §390 in the case of written orders by the Town. The Contractor acknowledges that the Contractor's sole remedy for any such claim will be an extension of time as provided herein.

10. Final Payment, Effect

The acceptance of final payment by the Contractor shall constitute a waiver of all claims by the Contractor arising under the Agreement.

11. Contract Documents

The Contract Documents consist of the following, together with this Agreement:

12. Terms Required By Law

This Agreement shall be considered to include all terms required to be included in it by the Mass General Laws, and all other laws, as though such terms were set forth in full herein.

13. <u>Indemnification</u>

The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Town from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising out of the performance of this Agreement when such claims, damages, losses, and expenses are caused, in whole or in part, by the acts, errors, or omissions of the Contractor or his employees, agents, subcontractors or representatives.

14. Insurance

The Contractor shall purchase and maintain such insurance as will protect both the Town and the Contractor from claims which may arise under the Agreement, including operations performed for the named insured by independent contractors and general inspection thereof by the named insured. In addition, the Contractor shall require its subcontractors to maintain such insurance. Coverage shall be provided for:

- .1 claims under workers' or workmen's compensation, disability benefit and other applicable employee benefit acts;
- .2 claims for damages because of bodily injury, occupational sickness or disease, or death of Contractor's employees;

- .3 claims for damages because of bodily injury, sickness or disease, or death of any person other than Contractor's employees;
- .4 claims for damages insured by usual personal injury liability coverage which are sustained (1) by any person as a result of an offense directly or indirectly related to the employment of such person by the Contractor, or (2) by any other person;
- .5 claims for damages, including damages to the Work itself, because of injury to or destruction of tangible property, including loss of use resulting therefrom; and
- .6 claims for damages because of bodily injury or death of any person or property damage arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of any motor vehicle.
- .7 claims involving contractual liability applicable to the Contractor's obligations.

The limits of liability for coverage required under the preceding paragraph shall be as Specified in the Supplemental Conditions.

Except for Workmen's Compensation, all liability coverage shall name the Town as an additional insured and shall provide for 30 days prior written notice to the Town of any modification or termination of coverage provided thereby. The Contractor shall provide the Town with appropriate certificate(s) of insurance evidencing compliance with this provision prior to the commencement of any work under this Agreement.

15. <u>Notice</u>

All notices required to be given hereunder shall be in writing and delivered to, or mailed first class to, Or emailed, the parties' respective addresses stated above. In the event that immediate notice is required, it may be given by telephone or facsimile, but shall, to the extent possible, be followed by notice in writing in the manner set forth above.

16. <u>Termination</u>

- A. Each party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement in the event of a failure of the other party to comply with the terms of the Agreement. Such termination shall be effective upon seven days' notice to the party in default and the failure within that time of said party to cure its default.
- B. The Town shall have the right to terminate the Agreement without cause, upon ten (10) days' written notice to the Contractor. In the event that the Agreement is terminated pursuant to this subparagraph, the Contractor shall be reimbursed in accordance with the Contract Documents for all Work performed up to the termination date, and for all materials or equipment not incorporated in the Work, but delivered and suitably stored at the site. Payment for material or equipment stored at the site shall be conditioned upon submission by the Contractor of bills of sale or such other evidence as is satisfactory to Town to establish the Town's title to such material or equipment or otherwise protect the Town's interests.

17. <u>Miscellaneous</u>

- A. Royalties and Patents: The Contractor shall pay all royalties and license fees. He shall defend all suits or claims for infringement of any patent rights and shall save the Town harmless from loss on account thereof, except that the Town shall be responsible for all such loss when a particular design, process or the product of a particular manufacturer or manufacturers is specified; but if the Contractor believes or has reason to believe that the design, process or product specified is an infringement of a patent, he shall be responsible for such loss unless he promptly gives such information to the Town, and thereafter the Town insists on the use of the design, process or product specified.
- B. Assignment: The Contractor shall not assign or transfer any of its rights, duties or obligations under this Agreement without the written approval of the Town.
- C. Governing Law: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- D. By its signature hereon, the Contractor certifies, under the pains and penalties of perjury, that it has complied with all laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts relating to taxes, reporting of employees and contractors, and withholding and remitting child support.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the said Surety, for value received hereby stipulates and agrees that no change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of the contract or to the work to be performed thereunder or the specifications accompanying the same shall in any way affect its obligation on this bond, and it does hereby waive notice of any such change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of this contract or to the work or to the specifications.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that no final settlement between the Town and the Contractor shall abridge the right of any beneficiary hereunder, whose claim may be unsatisfied.

Incorporation of Applicable Provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws

Certain provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws are applicable to Construction contracts including, but not limited to, those contained in Chapter 30 and Chapter 149. All applicable provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws are incorporated into the Contract as if fully set forth herein and shall prevail over any conflicting provisions of the General or Supplemental General Conditions.

SECTION 00900 <u>PAVING, MILLING, RECLAIM and Casting Adjustments</u> <u>SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS</u>

1. SCOPE OF WORK:

1. General:

- 1.1 The scope of work under this contract shall consist of furnishing labor and material at the request of the Town of Medway Highway Superintendent/designee to perform work set forth in the attached Quotation sheet in connection with **Paving, Milling, Reclaim and Casting Adjustments** services throughout the Town of Medway. Paving, Pavement Milling, cold planning of 2" depth, Pavement grinding, grade and roll, full depth reclamation of 10" and Casting Adjustments, Work on multiple roads within a week time period is typical.
- 1.2 This contract will include all work required to paving, berm, milling, reclaim, casting adjustments, contractor is responsible to schedule all subcontracts to complete scheduled work.
- 1.3 Contractor responsible to repair any damaged items, done by their subcontractor,
- 1.4 Work includes mobilization, scheduling of police details by Contractor, (Police details to be paid directly by Town of Medway), performance of the work, clean-up, and demobilization
- 1.5 Work covered herein is non-exclusive and the Town may elect to assign work to others at its discretion.
- 1.6 The Contractor shall provide coverage if unavailable for any reason.
- 1.7 The Contractor shall have at least 5 years of commercial roadway experience.
- 1.8 The Contractor shall provide all labor, all equipment, tools, construction equipment and machinery, transportation and other facilities and services necessary for the proper execution and completion of the work, whether temporary or permanent and whether or not incorporated or to be incorporated in the work. Such equipment shall include all roadside safety equipment including safety vests, signs, cones, and other traffic control devices. The Town to supply materials such as: asphalt, concrete, gravel, loam and seed. Trucking & delivery by Contractor.
- 1.9 Police details, when required, will be scheduled through the Medway Police Department by the Contractor. Direct billing/invoicing for police details shall be paid by the Town of Medway, All costs associated with failure to cancel a police detail due to the Contractor's need to reschedule the work shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 1.10 The Contractor shall provide a qualified Foreman who has a minimum of three years full time experience in Road work repair. Operators employed by the Contractor shall hold a valid Massachusetts Hoisting License where required by State law.
- 1.11 It is the responsibility of the contractor to remove and dispose of all waste material created while performing the work, unless directed otherwise by the Medway Highway Superintendent/designee. For the Millings and Recalim, The town will have a local location to dump your Millings and Reclaim.

1.12 The Contractor is expected to propose alternate equipment, materials, and/or installation techniques that would result in lower installed costs, better efficiency, lower lifetime maintenance, or other advantages to the Town of Medway.

2. Crew Requirements:

- 2.1 Contractor to submit and define what their standard crew and equipment is for their work. Additional men and equipment, if required, must be approved by the Medway Highway Superintendent or his designee prior to work to be eligible for payment.
- 2.2 Standard Hours: Monday through Friday onsite 7:00am to 3:30pm (with lunch), Overtime Hours starts after standard hours worked or called in for Saturday or Sunday.

3. AUTHORIZATION

- 3.1 The contractor and the Highway Superintendent/designee shall meet to discuss the scope of work and requirements for all work unless directed otherwise by the Medway Highway Superintendent/designee. A separate cost estimate based on contract unit pricing may be requested prior to release by the Highway Superintendent/designee.
- 3.2 Work shall be authorized by the Highway Superintendent/designee through the issuance of a work release. The service person's time is to start when he/she arrives at the jobsite and no travel time will be allowed. It shall be incumbent upon the service person to make contact with the Highway Superintendent/designee to record the time they begin and finish work.

4. <u>SCHEDULE</u>

- 4.1 Regular work shall be done during normal working hours, Monday through Friday. Work on any other days or hours must be specifically authorized by the Highway Superintendent /designee.
- 4.2 Work is scheduled by the Highway Superintendent/designee. In most cases, the Highway Superintendent will attempt to schedule a half day or full day of work for a standard road crew. Travel time not included in work hours
- 4.3 It is incumbent upon the Contractor to make contact with the Highway Superintendent prior to beginning work. Proper coordination is expected to ensure notification of other Town departments as required.
- 4.4 Upon receipt of an authorized work release for a specific project from the Highway Superintendent the Contractor shall notify the Highway Superintendent of the project schedule unless waived by the Department. The project schedule must include:
 - a. planned start date for the project. This date shall be no more than 30 days after the date of the authorized work release unless agreed to by the Highway Superintendent/designee.
 - b. planned duration and end date for the project.
 - c. any special requirements for staging of equipment and/or materials in the vicinity of the project.

- d. any special requirements for labor, material, or equipment to be supplied by others.
- 4.5 The Contractor shall inform the Highway Superintendent/designee of any changes in schedule at least 48 hours in advance of the planned start date.
- 4.6 Work is expected to be started and completed within a reasonable time period after authorized work release. Work unreasonably delayed or subject to multiple changes in planned start dates for reasons other than weather will be considered a breach of contract.
- 4.7 Once started, the work shall continue on each successive normal workday until it is completed. Interruptions in work to perform work for other customers shall not be allowed unless explicitly approved by the Highway Superintendent/designee in advance

5. <u>CODE REQUIREMENTS</u>

Unless directed otherwise, all work shall be executed in accordance with the latest Commonwealth of Massachusetts regulations, MassDOT Standard Specifications for Highways and Bridges latest addition, local inspection authorities and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). It shall be understood that these documents are intended to perform as a guide and that omission of any specific item or failure to mention any local, state or federal requirements or authorities of law specifically shall not relieve the Contractor from full and complete responsibility in furnishing a complete, code compliant and satisfactory installation.

6. <u>SITE MAINTENANCE</u>

- 6.1 The Contractor shall confine his apparatus, the storage of materials and the operations of his/her work to the limits prescribed by the Highway Superintendent/designee and shall not unreasonably encumber the project site with his materials. The Contractor shall, at all times, fully protect his work and materials from injury loss by others. Any injury or loss which may occur shall be made without expense to the Town of Medway. The Contractor shall be responsible for the proper protection of his materials and tools until the Work is accepted by the Highway Superintendent.
- 6.2 The Contractor at all times shall keep the premises free from accumulation of waste materials or rubbish caused by his operations. At the completion of the work he shall remove all his waste materials and rubbish from and about the Project as well as his tools, construction equipment, machinery, and surplus materials. Grounds shall be left in original condition except where otherwise approved by the Highway Superintendent/designee.

7. <u>APPROVALS</u>

- 7.1 The Highway Superintendent/designee will review and approve or take other appropriate action upon the Contractor submittals such as Shop Drawings, Product Data and Samples, but only for conformance with the design concept of the work and with the information given in the work release.
- 7.2 The Highway Superintendent/designee will have the authority to reject work that does not conform to the work release. The Contractor must use good workmanship in performing work as specified. The Contractor shall promptly correct any work rejected by the Highway

Superintendent/designee as defective or as failing to conform to the work release whether or not completed and shall correct any work found to be defective or nonconforming within 30 days.

8. BASIS FOR PAYMENT

- 8.1 Payment for each work release shall be made at the contract unit price for labor, materials, and any other items as required for the completion of the work release. Alternate payments schedules may be used for longer duration projects.
- 8.2 Invoices should be submitted upon completion of each work release and shall reference the work release. Include all material cost and the time they begin and finished work. Travel time not included in work hours. Submit all Massachusetts Weekly Certified Payroll Report with each Invoice.

WEEKLY PAYROLL RECORDS REPORT & STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

In accordance with Massachusetts General Law c149, section 27B, a true and accurate record must be kept of all persons employed on the public works construction project for which the enclosed rates have been provided. The *Weekly Payroll Report Form* includes all the information required to be kept by law. Every contractor or subcontractor is required to keep these records and preserve them for a period of three years from the date of completion of the project.

In addition, every contractor and subcontractor is required to submit a copy of their weekly payroll records to the awarding authority. This is required to be done on a weekly basis. Once collected, the awarding authority is also required to preserve those records for three years.

In addition, each such contractor, subcontractor or public body shall furnish to the Executive Office of Labor within fifteen days after completion of its portion of the work a statement, executed by the contractor, subcontractor or public body who supervises the payment of wages, in the following form:

For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.

• The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.

• All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.

• The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.

• Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.

• Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.

• Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.

• Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
